

## **NCLR/CSULB Health Center Receives \$249,862 Federal Grant**



The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has awarded a \$249,862 grant to the National Council of La Raza-California State University-Long Beach Center for Latino Community Health, Evaluation, and Leadership Training for a project – *Rompe el Silencio* or Break the Silence – aimed at reducing the instances of HIV infection among U.S. Latinas and their families. The grant was one of four awarded nationwide by the Office of Women's Health within the HHS.
